We welcome you into God's family! If you are interested in learning more about our church, or would like to join, please pick up a registration form at one of the entrances of the church, stop by the parish office, or call Father Danso for an appointment.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM: To have your child baptized you must be a registered parishioner in good standing for at least three months before requesting a baptismal date. Baptismal requests must be made at least one month before the desired date. A baptismal class is required for first time parents and other parents who have not had a formal baptismal class. The class is held on the first Tuesday of every month at 7:00 pm. Pre-registration is required by calling the parish office.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK (ANOINTING): Anointing is available upon request. It is available: in serious illness, before surgery & in emergency at anytime. Please call the parish office.

PASTORAL VISITATIONS: Please call the parish office when a parishioner is admitted to any of the hospitals or care centers. Hospitals no longer alert us to that information due to a confidentiality law. If a homebound parishioner would like a pastoral visit, or to receive the Eucharist, call the parish office. The Eucharist is taken to the homebound on Sundays by Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION (CONFESSION): Saturday 4:00 - 5:00 p.m. (April to September); 3:00 - 3:40 p.m. (October to March); or any other time by appointment.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION: The process of becoming a Catholic or completing the reception of the Sacraments of Initiation for adults or children is celebrated in the parish. Please call the parish office for further information.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY (MARRIAGE): To be married at the parish, you or your intended spouse or your parents must be a registered parishioner in good standing for at least six months before a date can be requested, with a minimum of six months for marriage preparation. The couple therefore needs to talk with a priest or deacon six months before the anticipated wedding date. Do not rent a hall for reception before seeing & meeting with a priest or deacon AND before your wedding is placed in the parish calendar. If a prior marriage is involved; one year notice may be necessary. Please plan accordingly.

EXPOSITION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT: First Fridays: Mass 8:30 a.m. followed by Exposition till 10:00 a.m.

EUCHARISTIC ADORATION: St. Patrick's Neola has Eucharistic Adoration every Thursday from 9:00 am to 8:00 pm. Anyone is welcome to come during this time for as long as you would like. We do have a schedule, so that we make sure someone is there at all times. Please contact the parish office for more information or you can find the schedule and sub list on our website.

### **HOMILY SUMMARY**

### Connecting the Gospel...

...to the First Reading: Isaiah announces that <u>salvation</u> is revealed in such wonders as making the blind see, the deaf hear, and the lame walk. These are exactly the works Jesus does, which are revealed to John the Baptist and to us that Jesus is "the Christ," the Savior.

...to the Second Reading: James, writing to his fellow Christians, encouraged them whilst they anticipated the Second Coming of Christ. They were positive it would happen soon. James counseled them to look to prophets like Isaiah as an example of patience during times of keen expectations.

### **Focusing the Gospel**

The <u>Gospel</u> begins with John questioning who Jesus is and concludes with Jesus extolling who John is. What makes John great is that he recognizes in "the work of the Christ," the person and presence of the Messiah, and "the one who is to come." This is exactly our **Advent challenge:** to see all the goodness around us in the works of Jesus and announce the presence of "the Christ." Advent calls us to look deeper and then to trust what we see. Whom we discover depends upon what we see.

...to experience: We learn who a person is by observing how that person lives and behaves. We learn who Jesus is by observing how *faithful believers live and behave*.


