Let Jesus' final words in today's Gospel propel us on our mission: "Without cost you have received; without cost you are to give." Without cost we have received the salvation Jesus won for us; without cost we are to share this gift.

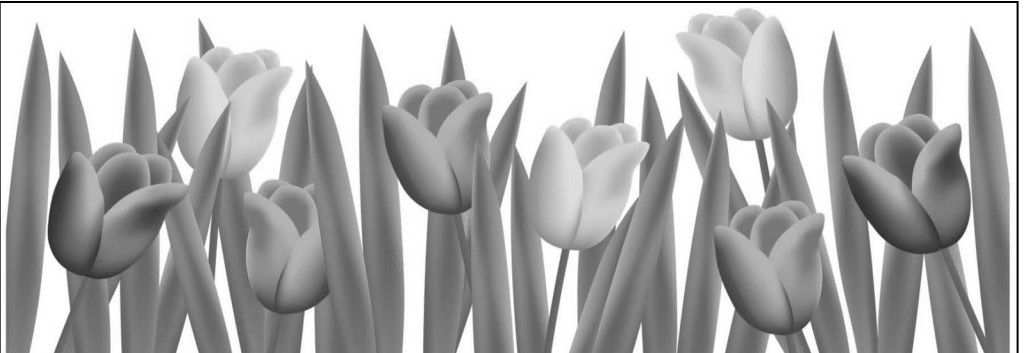
The Israelites have been God's chosen people from the time of Abraham and Sarah, "dearer to me than all other people," as the LORD tells Moses in the first reading. In the Gospel, Jesus tells his disciples that he was sent to return "the lost sheep of the house of Israel" to the fold. We are part of that fold now, "the sheep of his flock," as we sing in the psalm. Listening to God's word today, let us reflect on the privilege we have in being part of the flock we call the Church, rescued from the world of sin by our Good Shepherd.

The Chosen People decided to pitch their camp at the foot of Mount Sinai, the place they thought God's presence would most likely be found, as it was the highest mountain they'd seen. In fact, it was on this mountain that Moses would later receive the ten commandments. We have pitched our tent, so to speak, in this place, in this church, blessed by the bishop, and blessed with the Lord's presence whenever we gather to celebrate the Eucharist. May we realize how precious we are in the Lord's sight in this holy place.

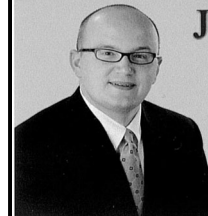
