On Father's Day, let us celebrate our fathers and father figures who watch over us, guide us, and do their best to make sure that not a hair on our heads will be harmed.

Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word

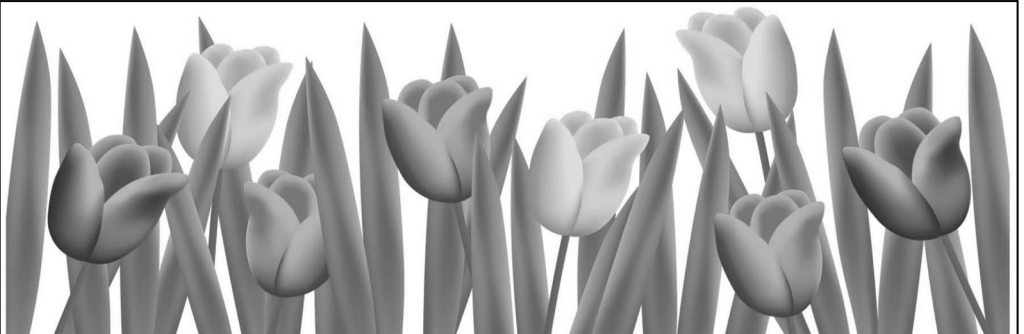
Last Sunday we heard Jesus choose the disciples whom he would send out to proclaim the kingdom of God. Today he calls upon them to go out and proclaim it from the housetops. But Jeremiah sets the tone for Jesus' instructions when he confesses his fear of those who would persecute him. Jesus reassures his disciples as Jeremiah reassures himself, that God will protect those who carry out the Lord's work. May God's word build our confidence in God's care and fidelity.

The instructions we hear Jesus give today are addressed to his disciples, but they can also be read as the instructions he has already given to himself, instructions he will follow all the way to the cross. "Fear no one" (Matthew 10:26): Jesus will not be afraid to speak out against the authorities and those with power. "Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul" (10:28): Jesus stands up to Herod and Pilate, knowing that they cannot harm his soul. "Not one [sparrow] falls to the ground without your Father's knowledge" (10:29): the Father will raise Jesus from the dead. This perspective makes our mission as Jesus' disciples easier, for we know that this all has been proven true.

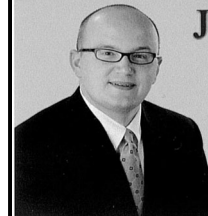
